Program overview

The seven-week course is designed to prepare you for the Anaplan L2 certification exam and includes the exam as part of the course. Modules cover:

Week 1	Introduction to Anaplan
Week 2	Importing, Revenue, Margin, Price Growth, Expense Modules
Week 3	Profit and Loss /Security
Week 4	Intro to Data Hubs/Production Models
Week 5	Common Errors/Model efficiency and performance
Week 6	Inventory Planning/Product Supply Manager
Week 7	Subsidiary Views/Best practices/The Anaplan Way/Exam prep

Each module will have a live virtual session with the instructor to discuss that week's topics. And will also include guest Anaplan professionals to give you "real world" experience of what you can expect in employment.
