Course Overview:

5 business modules designed specifically for service members and DoD personnel:

- **Communications** - US Business and professional styles, examples, contextual expectations: Why and how?
- **Organization, Administrative/legal, and Human Resources** - Common alignments, missions, and goals: What and why?
- **Business Finance and Accounting** - Common alignments, purposes, goals, models, and jargon: What and why?
- **Business Technology** - Common alignments, purposes, models, and jargon: What and why?
- **Information Security and Cyber Security** - Common alignments, purposes, models, and jargon: What and why?

Course is a mixture of online material and instructor led interaction. Materials will consist of literature and on-line content to be pre-assigned as base for in person discussion and practical application.

Course Structure:

- Course length 5 weeks, one module a week.
- The first session is 8 hours, in-person, Saturday, at the Tempe campus with select video participation. **We understand and support military obligations; in person is strongly preferred, prior exception for remote participation required.*
- Remaining 8 sessions will be twice a week, hybrid with in-person and remote/online accommodations for participation.
- Expected student effort 6-8 hours a week.

 - Overview of common finance and accounting functions purposes and alignments
 - How and why business strategy drives technology, data, security, and policies
