What do I need to know to take this class?

The content of this class is designed for students or working professionals from any field to be able to take this course with no prior experience with ServiceNow. Through a combination of theoretical knowledge and hands-on exercises, students will learn platform administration, IT Service Management (ITSM) concepts, ServiceNow platform implementation and requirement-gathering best practices, and additional guidance for successful processes surrounding a ServiceNow implementation.

Program overview

Upon completion, learners will have:

- In-depth knowledge of the ServiceNow platform, including its features, functionality, and use cases.
- Hands-on experience with all aspects of ServiceNow platform administration.
- Ability to design and implement automated workflows using Flow Designer.
- Understanding of ServiceNow subscription licenses and how to manage them.
- Introduction to Gen Al and how to use it to enhance ServiceNow capabilities.
- Ability to create and manage reports and dashboards.
- Ability to troubleshoot and optimize ServiceNow performance.
- Ability to develop and execute automated tests for ServiceNow applications.
- Eligibility to take the CSA associate-level certification exam.

This 6-week course provides hands-on experience with the ServiceNow platform, covering topics such as the platform overview, Flow Designer, subscription licenses, Gen Al, reporting, performance analytics, and automated test frameworks.

- Week 2: ServiceNow Administration Fundamentals
- Week 3: Flow Designer Fundamentals
- Week 4: Flow Designer Micro-certification, Subscription Management, and Intro to Gen Al
- Week 5: Reporting & Performance Analytics
- Week 6: Automated Test Framework Essentials Path & Prep for CSA exam
